Money Dice Game

DESCRIPTION

This activity has been developed to help young participants recognise coins. The activity is aimed at generating increased familiarisation with Australian currency.

Each child in the group gets a turn of rolling the money dice and is encouraged by the facilitator to call out the amount. In the second round two dice are rolled and children are encouraged to add up the amounts of the coins.

TIME

10 – 20 minutes

AGE APPROPRIATENESS

4-6	6-8	9-11	12-14	15-18
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LEARNING OUTCOMES

- Identification / familiarisation of currency
- Increases financial vocabulary
- Increase skills with financial calculations

INSTRUCTIONS

Ask students to sit in a circle. Each student gets to roll one dice and is encouraged to call out the amount on the dice rolled. Then two dice go around the circle and students are encouraged to add up and call out the amounts until each student had a turn.
